VERY IMPORTANT!

IF YOU CURRENTLY HAVE OR PLAN TO HAVE A BUSINESS REGISTERED WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE, READ THE FOLLOWING.

As a result of the enactment of the Corporate Transparency Act which is effective January 1, 2024, you may be required to file a beneficial ownership information report. This report includes information such as name, date of birth, address and a unique identifying number such as a driver's license, passport, etc. with an image of such document. The filing of this report is required when any entity that is a limited liability corporation (LLC), limited partnership, general partnership, S corporation, C corporation, or business trust has one or more owners who own at least 25% of the entity or control of it. This is also required if the entity has any individual who exercises either directly or indirectly a very broad definition of control that would exist, as an example, in businesses whose ownership is in trust.

This form must be filed electronically through the Financial Crimes Enforcement Network. Failure to file this form, when you are required to do so, may result in very severe financial or criminal penalties.

If your business was registered prior to January 1, 2024, you must file this report by December 31, 2024. If you form and register a business after January 1, 2024, you must file this report within 90 days of registering the business.
